FACT: Measure Q ensures regular maintenance and repair of San Marcos' 200+ miles of streets, keeping them in good condition, fixing potholes, and improving traffic flow.

FACT: Measure Q keeps our 300 acres of parks, trails, and lakes safe, clean, and well-maintained for years to come.

FACT: Essential purchases – groceries, prescription medicine, diapers, and feminine hygiene products – are exempt from Measure Q.
