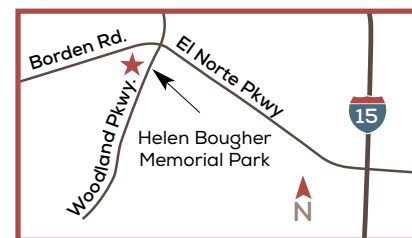

BORDERLANDS HIKE SERIES: Discover the landscapes and communities surrounding San Marcos on hikes that venture just beyond the city limits.

San Elijo Hills South Tour

Saturday, September 5 • 8 a.m. (Sign-in at 7:30 a.m.)

Moderate-to-Strenuous: This short but challenging, 3.5-mile hike will start at San Elijo Hills Park and take in a circle tour of the southernly San Elijo Hills area. Trails to explore include the Copper Creek, Garden, Wild Canyon and Make-A-Wish trails. Expect 760' of elevation gain.

Meeting location: San Elijo Hills Park, 1105 Elfin Forest Road, San Marcos 92078 (Recreation Center parking lot)

WATERSHED HIKE SERIES: Each hike explores the unique and diverse environments that connect San Marcos to neighboring communities, featuring lakes, rivers, and creeks along the way.

Mule Hill Historical Trail

Saturday, October 3 • 8 a.m. (Sign-in at 7:30 a.m.)

Easy: Start from the Sikes Adobe Historic Farmstead to enjoy a scenic 6.4-mile hike on the Mule Hill Historical Trail towards Raptor Ridge. Little to no elevation gain.

Meeting location: San Dieguito River Park Parking Lot, 12655 Sunset Dr., Escondido 92025 (south of Via Rancho Parkway past The Hodges Golf Learning Center)

BORDERLANDS HIKE SERIES: Hike beyond San Marcos and discover the connections that tie our community to the region around us.

Las Posas Park to Highlands

Saturday, November 7 • 9 a.m. (Sign-in at 8:30 a.m.)

Moderate: "Rambling ups and downs" best describe this adventurous 4.0-mile loop hike to one of the northern points of the City. Parks to be visited will be Las Posas, Santa Fe Hills, Foothills, Las Abejas and Quail Valley. There will be approximately 655' of elevation gain.

PEAKS HIKE SERIES: Challenge yourself to reach San Marcos' highest peaks and enjoy spectacular 360-degree views.

High Trek Classic

Saturday, December 5 • 9 a.m. (Sign-in at 8:30 a.m.)

Strenuous: Start out at Lakeview Park, ascend to the Ridgeline Trail and then head west. Reach the microwave towers, make the descent through Lake San Marcos and return to the starting point via Cima and Discovery Creek Trails. Approximately 6 miles and elevation gain of 1,115'.

Fire and Flora:

How Wildfires Shape the Land

Saturday, September 12 • 9 a.m. (Sign-in at 8:30 a.m.)

Join us for a one mile walk around South Lake as we explore the vital role fire plays in our local chaparral ecosystem. Along the way, we'll discuss how native plants and animals have adapted to thrive in arid conditions, learn about wildfire prevention, and take in the natural beauty South Lake has to offer. Afterwards, stick around to paint your own rocks based on your favorite plant of the day!

Creatures of the Dark:

Halloween Edition

Along the trail, we'll separate myths from reality, explore the fascinating adaptations that help these creatures survive after dark, and learn why many of nature's "spookiest" animals are important helpers in our ecosystem.
